# Be a Private Pilot

### Requirements

- 1. Be at least 17 years of age. (16 years old to become a student pilot)
- 2. Be able to read, speak, write, and understand the English language
- 3. Meet minimum flight training, and test requirements (FAR 61)

## What you need to start full flight lessons

- 1. Proof of US citizenship, or get TSA approval
- 2. Buy a logbook

Your instructor will then guide you to apply for a student pilot certificate, and aviation medical exam, and required supplies.
