NEW WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Construction of a **New Water Treatment Plant** at the **City of Mt. Carmel** was finance by the **Clean Water** State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This project **includes the construction of a new drinking water treatment facility, upgrades to water supply wells, and upgrades to the water distribution system.** Once complete, this project will provide safe, clean, and reliable drinking water to area residents and businesses in the **City of Mt. Carmel.** SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
