## Be a Private Pilot

### Requirements:

- Be at least 17 years of age.
  - 16 years old to become a student pilot
- Be able to read, speak, write and understand English language.
- Meet minimum flight training and testing requirements.

## What you need to start full flight lessons

- Proof of US citizenship or get TSA approval.
- Buy a logbook.
- Aviation medical Exam
- Miscellaneous required supplies.

## Your instructor will then guide you to apply for a student pilot certificate.

### Estimated Costs

• Aircraft rental	40 hours (minimum) @ \$110/hr.	\$4,400
• Instructor (Dual Time)	20 hours (minimum) @ \$40/hr.	\$ 800
• Supplies		\$ 600
• Other (including testing)		\$ 600
		Total \$6.400
